

## A Guide for Acquiring Police Conducts

Malta Gaming Authority





This document is intended to serve as a guideline for respective applicants and entities that seek to obtain an approval from the Malta Gaming Authority (MGA/Authority).

The following is a list of countries including but not limited to those which the MGA has received applications from. They are indexed together with the respective links from where to acquire a certificate of good conduct/police certificate.

It is imperative to point out that the following list is subject to change, and therefore should not be considered as an exhaustive list. Moreover, the Authority applies a risk-based approach and always reserves the right to require further information and/or documentation from any applicant.

The list below consists of the issuance of police certificates from several jurisdictional authorities wherein the individual resides/ed or is a national of. For those applicants who no longer reside within the country from which a police certificate is required, and electronic applications are not possible, common alternative suggestions were noted including, but not limited to, the following:

- Apply at a nearby local embassy or consulate representing the respective country;
- Consult/contact the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the respective country;
- Authorise an individual to apply on the applicant's behalf; or
- Contact directly the local enforcement through the links outlined for further information/instructions as to how to proceed.
