The WPBSA is the regulatory authority for both Billiards and Snooker worldwide. It is responsible for the global development of both sports, for the Governance and integrity in relation to the sports, for providing player support which is as professional as possible as well as for the development concerning coaches.

Nigel Mawer QPM, WPBSA's Vice Chairman stated that "This is an important step forward in the battle against match-fixing and betting issues in snooker. I am really pleased to have the support of the MGA, and the MGA's Sports Integrity team in combating corruption in sport."

The MGA's Sports Integrity Manager, Antonio Zerafa stated that "In these unprecedented times many were those who had to shift their focus away from team sports. In consequence, more light was shed on more individualistic sports. Hence, this period proved to be a perfect example of how stakeholders of sports and sports betting integrity need to widen their horizons in terms of collaboration. Our recent data-sharing agreement with the WPBSA places us in a position to be able to also assist individualistic sports in their fight against corruption."
