GENERAL CONDITIONS

The granting of a licence of a non-profit game (tombola game) is subject to the following conditions and any other conditions that the Director (Lotteries) after consultation with the Malta Gaming Authority, may from time to time deem expedient:-

- a) The price for each tombola scoresheet participating in the relevant tombola game shall not exceed seventy Euro cents (€ 0.70), and when the said tombola game can be played by a tombola scorecard or a number of tombola scorecards which fall short of a whole tombola scoresheet, the price of each such tombola scorecard shall not exceed such proportion of seventy Euro cents (€ 0.70) equivalent to the proportion which the total number of numbers, symbols or pictures printed or otherwise electronically represented on such tombola scorecard bears to the total number of numbers, symbols or pictures participating in the relevant tombola game and printed or otherwise electronically represented on a tombola scoresheet participating in such game;
- b) Not less than *sixty per centum* (60%) of the amount collected in sales of tombola scoresheets and tombola scorecards participating in the relevant tombola game shall be distributed in prizes in respect of such game or *fifty five per centum* (55%) and the other *five per centum* (5%) is allocated to the snowball;
- c) A statement showing the number of scoresheets sold, the denomination of each sheet, the amount of money collected in the sales in respect of each tombola game held in a session and the method of distribution of the amount due as prizes is kept by the permit holder or tombola supervisor for inspection by the Malta Gaming Authority's inspector and, or any other person authorised and, or designated for this purpose by the Authority;
- d) The tombola session, which cannot exceed the period of six hours, is held within the official premises of the non-profit organisation permitted to hold the tombola session or if so authorised at any other place authorised by the Malta Gaming Authority;
- e) Non-profit organisations permitted to hold tombola sessions may not hold such tombola sessions in tombola (bingo) halls in respect of which permission has been granted to hold commercial tombola gaming;
- f) A non-profit game licence may not be assigned or transferred by the non-profit game licensee to any other person;
- g) The non-profit game licensee may not surrender the non-profit game licence during the licence term without the prior approval in writing of the Malta Gaming Authority, and if such approval is given, the licence may then be surrendered only subject to such terms and conditions as may be specified by the Authority in its approval;
- h) The non-profit game licensee shall pay the Ministry of Finance, Economy and Investment on behalf of the Government a duty of **thirty-four Euros and ninety-four cents (€ 34.94)** in respect of each tombola session.

Applications should be made through the Malta Gaming Authority, SmartCity at least 15 days before commencement of tombola session
