

## Directive 6 of 2011

# Other Amusement Machines Directive 2011

In exercise of the powers conferred by regulation 18(4) of the Amusement Machines Regulations, the Malta Gaming Authority is hereby issuing the following directive in order to amend the Third Schedule of the Amusement Machines Regulations.

### Part I – Preliminary

1. The Short title of this Directive is the Other Amusement Machines Directive 2011.

### Part II – Definitions

2. In this Directive, unless the context otherwise requires:

**'Authority'** means the Malta Gaming Authority;

**'Directive'** means the Other Amusement Machines Directive;

**'Regulations'** means the Amusement Machines Regulations (S.L. 438.06).

### Part III – Applicability

3. This Directive applies to the Third Schedule of the Regulations whereby the Authority is amending the list of other amusement machines.

4. Paragraph 1 of the Third Schedule of the Regulations shall also include the following other amusement machines:

- i) air-hockeys unless operated electronically through video display;
- ii) children reaction games unless operated electronically through video display;
- iii) flipper and, or pinball unless operated electronically through video display;
- iv) sports simulation games unless operated electronically through video display. Provided that sports games and mechanical or electrical equipment ordinarily required for sports games shall not require an approval.
