

GENERAL CONDITIONS

The granting of a licence of a non-profit Lottery is subject to the following conditions and any other conditions that the A/Director (Lotteries) may from time to time deem expedient:

1. That the following information should be provided to the A/Director:
 - a) retail value/nature of prize/s that can be won;
 - b) number of prizes which can be won and number of prizes of any one type if more than one type of prize is on offer;
 - c) the rules governing who is eligible to participate and the award of prizes;
 - d) the date when the results will be announced and the manner in which they are announced;
 - e) the time period during which prizes must be collected (not more than one month from draw date);
 - f) details of prize-winning entries.
2. That the A/Director (Lotteries) shall have the right to send his representative for the selection procedure for the award of prizes at the expense of the Licensee, at a charge of €35.00 payable to the Malta Gaming Authority. Draws held at the Authority shall be charged at €12.00 per draw;
3. The cost to participate in a non-profit game shall not exceed €0.58 cents for every single participation;
4. The prize/s which can be won in such game shall not consist of money or cheque or similar document entitling the holder to convert it into money;
5. That in all pertinent advertisements, the licensee shall quote clearly the number of the MGA Licence;
6. That persons in the employ of the licensee or persons in any way connected with the game shall not be allowed to participate therein;
7. All prizes that remain unclaimed and, or uncollected after one month from the date on which prizes were drawn, the value of which shall be paid to the Ministry for Finance;
8. The A/Director may not grant a licence if the aggregate retail value of all prizes which can be won in such game/s exceeds the amount of €11,646.86;
9. The licensee may not surrender/change the non-profit game licence during the licence term without the prior approval in writing of the A/Director, and if such approval is given, the licence may then be surrendered/changed only subject to such terms and conditions as may be specified by the A/Director in his approval. The licence may not be transferred or assigned to any other person.
10. The licensee shall pay to the Ministry for Finance through the Malta Gaming Authority a rate of duty of twenty-five per centum (25%) on the aggregate retail value of all prizes which can be won in such game.
11. The total sales in Euros (€) and number of tickets are to be reported to the MGA by no later than one (1) day after the draw has taken place.

Failure to abide by these conditions will be considered as a breach of the Public Lotto Ordinance and renders the defaulters to the penalties contemplated therein.

This LICENCE does not exempt the Licensee from obtaining any other permission that may be required under the Police or other Laws.
