Notice of Cancellation

Dear Mr. Kolaas,

Please be advised that the Malta Gaming Authority (hereinafter referred to as the 'Authority') has identified the following breaches of the Compliance and Enforcement Regulations (S.L. 583.06) (hereinafter referred to as the 'Regulations') by Join Games Malta Limited (hereinafter referred to as the 'Authorised Person'), namely:

- a) the Authorised Person has failed to comply with one or more applicable obligations in terms of any regulatory instrument or any other applicable law of Malta following the non-submission of the key function roles list within the stipulated time and the Authorised Person has failed to inform the Authority of the change in directorship occurring within the company, specifically when Mr. Hans Magnus Kolaas was appointed as Director with effective date being June 13th, 2019 and Mr. Luigi Spina resigned from the said post held by him on the same day;
- b) the Authorised Person has failed to pay in a timely manner all amounts due to the Authority; in that the Authorised Person has failed to effect payment of €25,000 representing the licence fee for the year 2019 which was due for settlement by the 15th November 2019.

In view of the foregoing, the Authority is hereby tendering a formal notice of cancellation of the Authorisation granted to Join Games Malta Limited, in terms of regulation 10(1) of the Regulations.

In terms of regulation 10(2)(a) of the Regulations, the Authority is hereby requesting the Authorised Person to show cause, in writing, within a period of twenty (20) days commencing from the date of this Notice of Cancellation, as to why the Authorisation should not be cancelled.

Provided that if the Authorised Person fails to exercise the right to show cause why the Authorisation should not be cancelled within the aforementioned period, the Authority may proceed with the cancellation of the Authorisation.

The Authority shall take all the necessary legal measures which it deems expedient in order to ensure that the provisions of the Act and of any other regulatory instrument or any other law are fully adhered to.

Kindly be guided accordingly,
